SIMPLE WAYS TO PROTECT SEABIRDS WHILE VISITING ISLANDS:



1 PACK ON DAY OF TRAVEL

Re-pack kit that has been in storage, particularly bulky items or items stored where rodents are likely, e.g. sheds and attics.

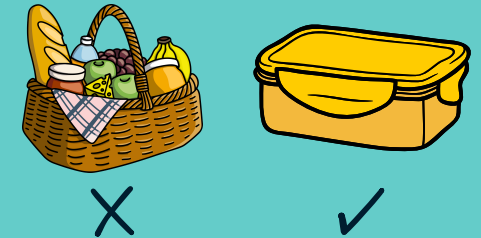
Ensure that bags are zipped up and boxes are sealed.



2 SEAL FOOD AND WASTE CONTAINERS

Keep all food and waste safe from mice in sealed containers.

Rubbish should be returned to mainland & disposed of responsibly.



3 WASH YOUR BOOTS

Reduce the risk of spreading disease and non-native plant seeds by washing and air drying boots between trips.



4 BE VIGILANT

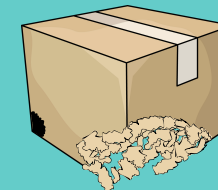
Never leave baggage unattended during the journey or at the quayside to avoid stowaways.

5 CHECK YOUR BAGGAGE

Check all bags, boxes and kit for signs of stowaways, including chew marks, holes, droppings and nest material BEFORE boarding the vessel.
